



It is covered in characteristic **soft, wavy coat**...



Body - 25 + 5 pt

medium size, medium length, hard and muscular, slender

neck elegant and slender

body weight heavier than the cat's appearance indicates

delicate bone structure

Body - 25 + 5 pt

back naturally curved

hips and thighs hard and muscular

> legs long, straight and slender, giving an overall appearance of being high on legs



paws small, oval, dainty

$\mathsf{Bod}(-25+5\mathsf{P}^\dagger)$

tail

long, fine and tapering, well covered with wavy hair, preferably without bare patches or being bushy

> torso slender, not tubular, showing a deep, but not broad chest


Body

- too small in size
- cobby
- lack of firm muscles
- short legs
- lack of elegance

Tail

- short tail
- bare or bushy tail





Coat - 35 pt

waves, quality and texture, no mention of the colour



Coat - 35 pt

CRX coat should always be stroked from the head to the tail. Backward stroking disrupts the lay of waves.

> And because of the fragility of the hairs, may cause damage in the form of splitting and breaking if repeatedly brushed in the wrong direction.

on a kitten or junior, unless the skin is felt,

if there is soft velvet or down everywhere.










